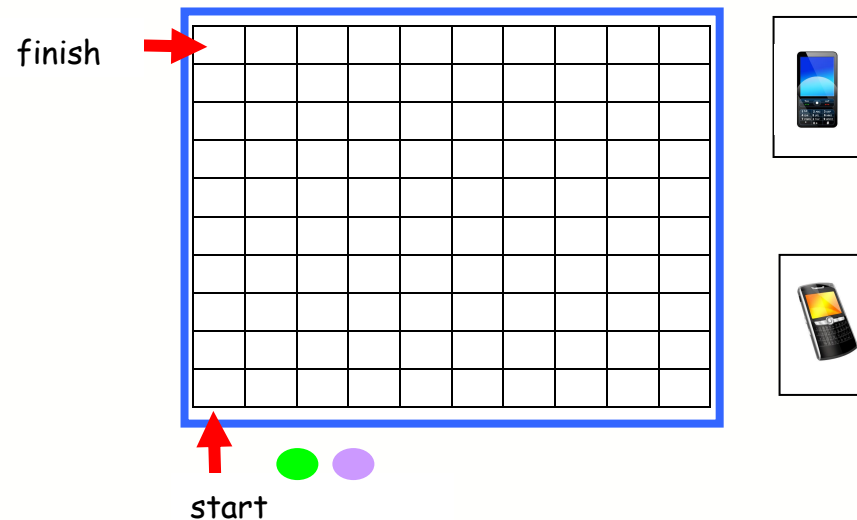
Phone Fever Game

To play the board game you will need:

- 1 Phone fever Game board
- A set of yellow and blue phone cards
- 1 dice
- 1 coloured counter per player

To play:

- Set up board with two sets of phone pictures in coloured piles, (yellow and blue screens)
- Toss the dice - the player with the highest number starts first
- Move the counter one space for each number on the dice
- If you land on a phone picture take a card from the right pile, read aloud and follow instruction
- Taking turns players make their way to the end of the board
- The player who gets to the end first wins
