Real Life Articles <u>Teacher Prompt Sheet</u>

Provide each group with a news article either from the resource Real Life Articles (11c) or locally sourced. Ask each group to read their article and discuss the following questions. As a whole class activity each group will then be asked to feedback from their articles and discussions.

Questions for consideration

- 1. What has happened?
- 2. What were the consequences to the persons involved?
- 3. What could the consequences be to the person's family?
- 4. What could be the impact on the wider community?
- 5. If any, who would be deemed as the winners and losers in this article?

Examples of possible discussion points/topics that may arise;

- Links to organised crime i.e. drugs, weapons, exploitation, terrorism
- Effect on local businesses decrease in trade
- Criminal families prospering in communities
- Environmental issues i.e. litter
- Impact on policing and health services
- Lost revenue loss to the community from tax evasion
- Exposes the young and the vulnerable to other areas of criminality
- Think about who the victims are in the wider sense
- Could encourage young people to start smoking
